Information and decision support system for tourism managers, media, students, ...

- Provides free and easy access to tourism statistics
- Platform for tourism associations to exchange data/information/knowledge



- Supports the harmonization of tourism statistics
- Tool to learn about the actual usage of tourism market research information
- Increases the application of management science models in tourism

- Arrivals (annual and monthly data)
- Bednights (annual and monthly data)
- 60 markets, including domestic visitors
- Capacities (# of hotels and bed spaces, annual data)
- Average occupancy rate, average length of stay
- Number of visitors to major attractions
- Shopping barometer

History of www.tourmis.info


- 1984** ANTO decides to install a Management Information System (MIS) on a mainframe computer
- 1990** 1st PC version (approx. 50 users)
- 1998** www.tourmis.info
- 1999/2000** European Cities Tourism (ECT/ECM) and the European Travel Commission (ETC) start using TourMIS for exchanging tourism statistics
- 2001** New data source: Number of visitations to Austrian attractions
- 2003** New executive summary tool
- 2004** Collection of monthly statistics (100,000+ online queries)
- 2005** First TourMIS Workshop (Brussels)
- 2007** New tool for analyzing seasonality
- 2008** ECM Shopping Barometer, UNWTO Ulysses Award
- 2011** www.citytourismbenchmark.com
- 2013** 9th TourMIS Workshop & International Seminar

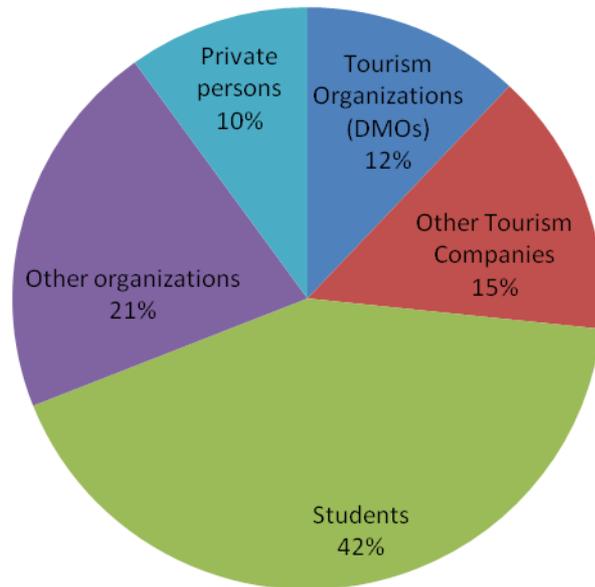




Origin of Users and Inquiries

Changes & New Features 2013

- **Upgrade of Perl 5.16.3**
- **Added 18 cities to database and Excel templates**
 - ✓ Ankara, Biarritz, Bucharest, Espoo, Kiev, Mechelen, Moscow, Nicosia, Podgorica, Poznan, Ravenna, Riga, Rouen, Sofia, St. Petersburg, Tbilisi, Thessaloniki, Toulon
- **Revision of the flexible Excel interface**
 - ✓ Sort Excel interface drop-down menu alphabetically
 - ✓ Option for copying the Excel interface from another region of the same country (e.g. Zurich uses the templates of Geneva)
 - ✓ All users should be able to edit (not delete) the Excel interfaces which are defined on the basis of Excel templates
 - ✓ 'Back to previous menu' button also on the page where someone can edit/create an Excel interface

- Automatic upload feature for Belgium regions
- Fixed assignment of markets to continents
 - ✓ Saudi Arabia and UAE → Asia (adjusted data input forms, **Excel template!**)
 - ✓ **Added a new feature which gives an error message if data inputters try to upload data using an outdated standard Excel template**
 - ✓ Georgia → Europe; Armenia, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan → Asia (Belgium upload feature)
- Revision of executive reports ('Latest Trends')
 - ✓ Improved format of the page select button
 - ✓ Excel download for city tourism exec report

- **ECM Shopping barometer**
 - ✓ Removed section about hotel prices
 - ✓ Fixed problem with currency exchange rates
 - ✓ Increased participation of ECM members entering data
- **Revision of the portfolio analysis tool**
 - ✓ Added preferred definition
 - ✓ Selected markets can be saved
- **New tool for measuring the diversity of the international guest mix of a TourMIS destination**

TourMIS has 223 data inputters (149 ECM, 74 ETC) Authorized persons should ...

- ... at least have a minimum knowledge on tourism statistics in his/her region (particularly about where to get information and how to read and interpret these tables)
- own a personal e-mail address (not an “office address” like office@modul.ac.at) and have access to the Internet at his/her desk
- be registered on TourMIS
- be willing to enter statistics on a regular basis

Before you start entering your figures you need to **check the definitions available in TourMIS **and the methodologies** used for generating your data in your destination!**

A few questions to think about ...

- Hotels or similar vs. collective/paid vs. all forms?
- Bednights or roomnights?
- Do bed/room-nights (arrivals at the place of accommodation) also include small units?
- Do your figures include data generated by unpaid forms of accommodation (VFR)?
- Does capacity information (# of accommodation suppliers, # of bed spaces) cover the same units as numbers on arrivals and/or bednights?
- **For city tourism:** Does your statistics cover the surrounding region or the “city area” only??



10. Number of hotels and similar establishments


What is City Tourism?



- **Criteria to become a member of ECM**
 - More than 100,000 inhabitants
 - More than 3,000 beds in commercial accommodation
 - Conference facilities
 - A significant monumental and historic heritage
 - Cultural events
- **Other criteria**
 - Visitors' perceptions
 - Survey
 - Avg length of stay < 3
 - Self-image



What are the Boundaries of a City?



- **Definitions discussed by ECM**
 - Political city limits
 - City area defined by the population density
 - Area defined by the places usually visited by city break visitors
 - Area accessible by public transportation from the city center (within a certain period of time)
 - Limits defined by the responsibility of the local tourist office
